## Itinerary:

### Day 1: San Francisco

- Arrival in San Francisco
- Transfers to hotel
- From the hotel, we walk to Lombard Street that famously zig-zags then down to the Coit Tower passing by the City Light Bookstore.
- Then we reach the Fisherman's Wharf where we will see the famous harbour seals, try some crab or some sour dough bread...
- Visit the Aquarium of the Bay
- (option) Cruise the bay to get a close look at the Golden Gate bridge

### Day 2: San Francisco

- Morning: Visit Alcatraz
- Lunch: discover some of the best Dim-Sum east of Hong Kong
- Afternoon: Bike across the Golden Gate Bridge
- Ride the cable cars while on city tour
- Evening: Enjoy a baseball game at Candlestick Park (schedule permitting). If not, we will replace activity with an equivalent one

### Day 3: San Francisco-Sequoia

- Drive down to Monterey Bay (check out of hotel) to Big Sur to Paso Robles
- Stop at San Simeon Hearst Castle and the guided tour
- From here we drive down to Sequoia National Park and arrive at hotel

### Day 4: Sequoia to Death Valley

- Explore the tall sequoia trees of the national forest
- Then drive to one of the most forbidding landscapes on the planet-Death Valley National Park
- Go to Badwater-the lowest point in the USA where you will be surrounded by 11,000 foot mountain peaks
- From Death Valley, a stop at Victorville Airport where airplanes are stored
- Arrive in LA and check in to hotel (surrounding area)

## Day 5: Los Angeles

- Leisure Day at Universal Studios
- Afternoon/Evening: Tour of Hollywood Boulevard and Beverly Hills

## Day 6: Los Angeles

- Leisure Day at Disney Land

## Day 7: Los Angeles to San Diego

- Morning: Visit the Farmer's Market and Santa Monica Pier
- Depart for San Diego

## Days 8, 9, 10 & 11: San Diego with families

- Various activities with families and San Diego organization
- Trip to San Diego Aquarium

## Day 12: San Diego

- Explore San Diego, (Downtown, Mission and Pacific Beaches)
- Dinner in Old Town

## Day 13: San Diego

- Visit world famous San Diego Zoo

### **Additional Information:**
